

Practical Tasks:

Each task is different. The subjects are as follows:

**Task 1: A landscape scene**

**Task 2: A person or a flowering shrub**

**Task 3: A tiny object (no bigger than a golf ball)**

Here is an example for TASK 1:

Take several shots of your subject using different focal lengths (zooming in and out) to see the difference in what your camera captures at the different focal lengths.

They should look something like this:



Image taken at 18mm



Image taken at 55mm



Image taken at 80mm



Image taken at 300mm

You then choose the one that you like the best. In the example above, I would choose the image taken at 18mm because it includes the whole scene, giving it perspective.

I would also include in my answer the reasons why I did not choose each of the other images.

Upload with your assignment only the image you have chosen. I do not need to see any of the others.

You tell me about the differences in the images and why you chose the one you chose.

For tasks 2 and 3, you repeat the process, using a person or flowering shrub as your subject for task 2 and a tiny object for task 3.
